Articulated College Credit is a state agreement between North Carolina high schools and the North Carolina Community College System that allows students to earn college credit while in high school. Many high school Career & Technical Education (CTE) courses allow students to receive college credit through either the state or local articulation agreement. This letter is a local agreement between Davidson County Schools and Davidson-Davie Community College. Other courses may be available for articulated credit. However, a special request must be made for any course(s) not on this list that are on the list approved by DDCC faculty and are listed NCCCS Articulation Agreement. The full list is available by request.

If you have taken any of the CTE high school courses listed in the chart below **AND** you meet the following grade guidelines, you may be eligible for articulated college credit at Davidson-Davie Community College.

1. Receive a **final course average of B or higher** in the course, **AND**;
2. Receive a **final exam grade of 93** on the CTE post-assessment. (COVID-19 exception for 19-20, 20-21 school year)

Students have two years from their high school graduation date to apply for articulated credit.
