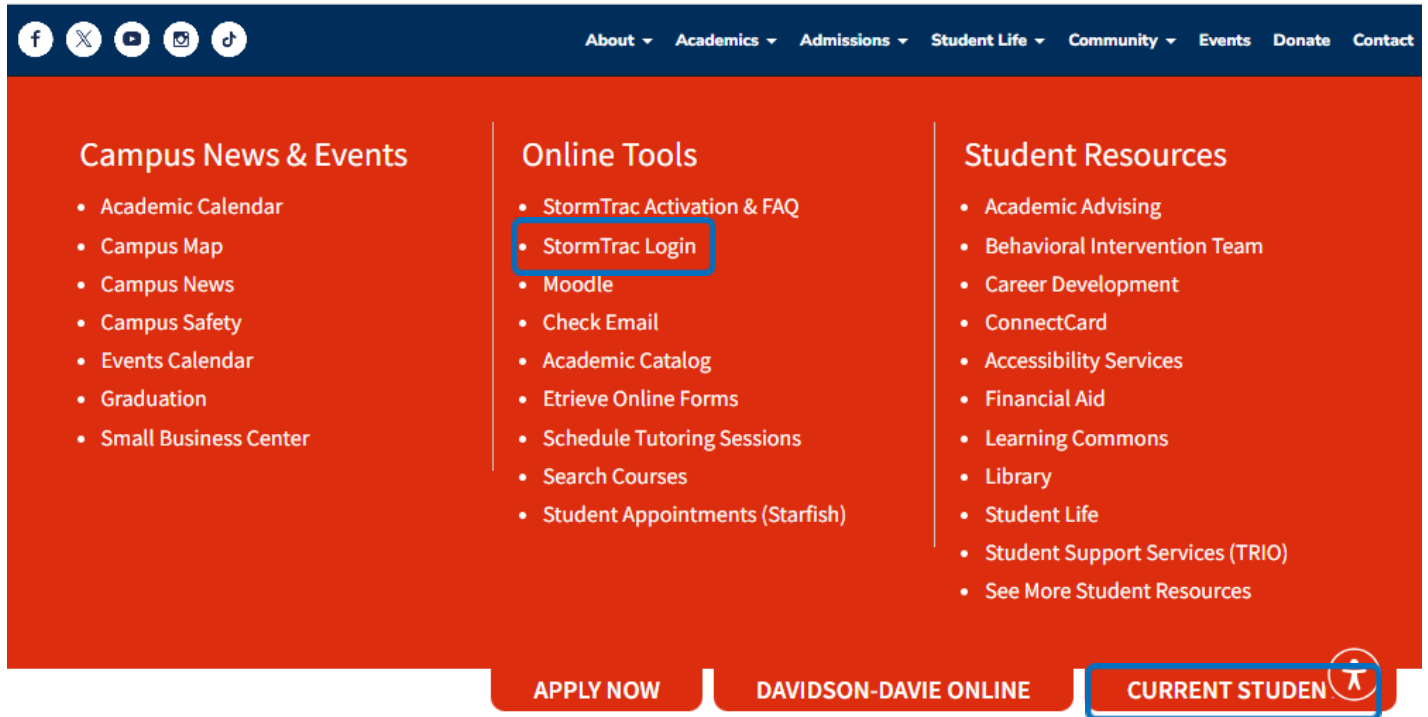
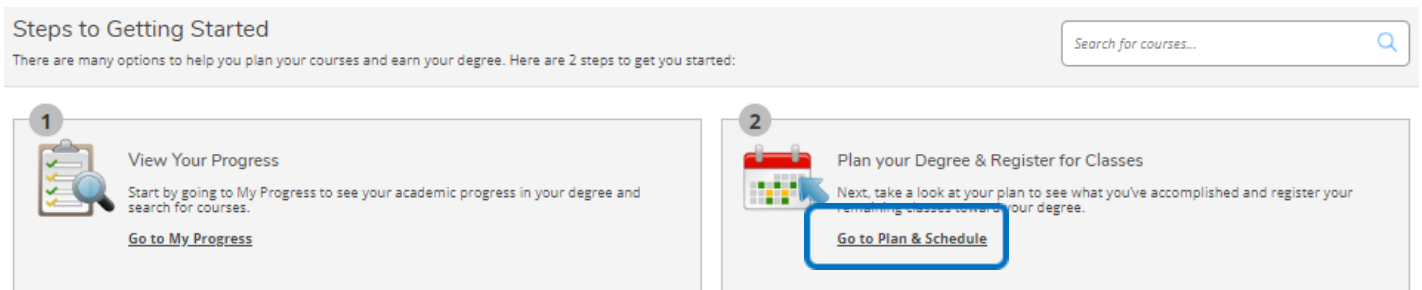


Registering for Classes in Student Planning

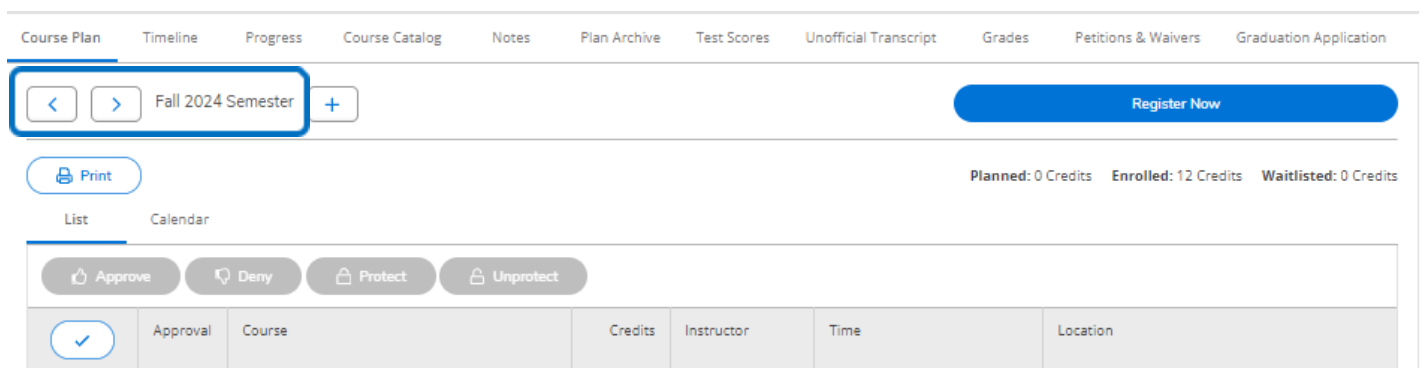
1. From Davidson-Davie Community College homepage, click on **Current Student** and then click on **StormTrac login** under Online Tools.



2. Once signed in, click on the Student Planning tab. In the Academic Planning area, click on **Plan & Schedule**



3. Use the arrows to select the semester/term you are trying to register for. Classes approved by your advisor will show up in the left column. Click on the calendar tab to view your courses in calendar format.



- Click on View other sections to see all class offerings for the semester. Please see the course section details for campus location, class times, and start dates. Click on the **DDCC Course Section Designation** for the description and explanation of section numbers and letters. Once you find the section you would like to register for, click on the section and select Add Section to Schedule.
